Students enroll in college-level classes at their home high school, while meeting Maryland State Department of Education graduation requirements.

Students enroll part time at HCC to earn college credit with multi-aged learners, while meeting Maryland State Department of Education graduation requirements.

Students enroll full time at HCC to earn 30-60 credits with multi-aged learners, while meeting Maryland State Department of Education graduation requirements.

Students enroll full time at HCC to earn up to 60 credits in cohort-based classes for an associate degree in general studies and a high school diploma. Students also receive additional support and learning opportunities to achieve their goals.

Students enroll part time or full time at HCC to earn college credits with the option to meet graduation requirements for high school or work toward an associate degree.
